PITLC was successful in getting a grant from the DNR to do a study of all the lakes in PITLC for invasive species, to be done in 2019 and 2020. Armour Lake is in the group for 2020. Each lake in PITLC had to contribute to the study depending on its size, and our financial commitment to the study is \$222.12, which was in the application to the DNR. Each lake had to send in a letter pledging our commitment to this effort.

You will be pleased to note the Presque Isle Town Lakes Committee was just awarded all 4 lake study grants applied for in December 2018. This means the following lakes' field work will be undertaken in 2019 and 2020:

Groups 2 and 3 – proposed field work to be undertaken during the summer of 2019  
Annabelle, Anne, Averill, Presque Isle, Red Bass, Van Vliet, Wildcat

Groups 1 and 4 – proposed field work to be undertaken during the summer of 2020  
Armour, Big, Crab, Horsehead, Little Crab, North Crab

PITLC will confirm the study years with the vendor shortly. As a reminder we will ask for your lake's commitment funds for groups 2 and 3 in the first quarter of 2020; for groups 1 and 4 in the first quarter of 2021. All this will be reviewed at the April 9 PITLC meeting. Don't forget we will want your summary of volunteer hours annually each year in the 4th quarter.
